Discus Throw - Two combined frisbee throws must be thrown at least 40 feet, but not more than 50 feet.

50 Meter Race - The parents will spin around a bat and then attempt to run 50 meters.

50 Meter Low Hurdles - In the style of the three legged race the parent and pal will attempt to complete a race with low hurdles.

(Food Eating) Relay Race - Taking turns the relay team (Parent and Pal) will attempt to eat a variety of foods including; pickles, marshmallows, ketchup, bananas, peanut butter, cookies and whole watermelons (kidding).
