NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC/ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all the rules in effect at the time of this trial. Exhibitors Handbooks are available free of charge by downloading from NADAC's web site at <u>www.nadac.com</u>. A hard copy of the handbook may be requested through the NADAC office free to current members and \$5.00 to non-members.

- All dogs including Novice must have a NADAC dog registration number when entering a trial. Entries will not be accepted for dogs using "pending" in lieu of a number.
- If you have an Australian Shepherd which is registered with ASCA, or a tracking number from ASCA, fill in the dog's number on the ASCA Registration/Tracking No. line on the entry form. If you do not have an ASCA number, leave the line blank.

There shall be no refunds, cancellations, or changes for entries after the closing date, unless a veterinarian certificate verifies a bitch is in season.

Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds for entries if a dog or handler is dismissed from a competition for any reason. Anyone not in good standing with NADAC/ASCA will not be allowed entry. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

This event will be held indoors on a dirt/sand mix. Dogs must be kept under control at all times and must be on a leash unless competing. Bring your own chairs, pens or crates, and water. Benching space will be limited.

Class Changes

Competitors are required to advise Trial Secretary of any changes achieved after entering this trial no later than Tuesday, May 24, 2005.

If you complete a title on Saturday, you may move up to the next level on Sunday. There will be NO same day move ups. Class move up forms will be available at the Table Steward's location. Please place them in the designated box BY THE END OF THE DAY. You are not required to move up to the next level until you wish to.

Check In and Measuring

Only dogs entering the Small and Medium dog classes are required to be measured at the trial prior to competing unless they have a NADAC permanent height card. Please bring height cards with you. Dogs will be measured Friday evening from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM as well as Saturday and Sunday from 7:00 AM to 7:30 AM.

Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in each class, as well as qualifying ribbons.

Special prizes will be awarded based on cumulative totals of all 8 rounds (Regular, Gamblers and Jumpers only) for the weekend. There will be prizes for the Top Novice, Top Open and Top Elite dog/handler teams. These prizes will be prorated based on the cumulative totals of all six (6) rounds of Regular and Jumpers only during the weekend.

Please note that dogs that have previously competed at a higher lever than the one entered at this HDDAC trial will not be eligible for a Top Dog Prize.

1.1 As used here "NADAC" means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. As used here "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and ASCA, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor /owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor /owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC and ASCA (including NADAC and ASCA officers, directors, employees, and members), the Hot Diggity Dogs Agility Club (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), and Burnt Lake Stables (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises.
