

Phonemic Notation
(Unified Padanian Orthography)

The standard system of tonic vowels employed in the reconstruction of Padanian archetypes is that of the central and western dialects, with the originally metaphonic diphthongs ie and uo restricted to open syllables, and ɛ and ɔ normalized in closed syllables. Phonemic length distinctions are standardized only for the oral mid vowels (e, o, ɛ, ɔ) and nasal a and e. Where necessary, stress is indicated by the acute accent over e, o and i, and the grave accent over a, ɛ, ɔ and u. The diaeresis is used to separate vowels, as in French, e.g. païs, Israël, Cafarnaüm. Apophonic alternation is generally accepted, cf. lieva ~ levar, tousa ~ toseta.
