YOUTH CONVENETION 2007

The International Wesleyan Youth

Convention, Set Apart 07, took place in Orlando, FL December 28th-31st. Around 7,000 teens and youth workers from around

the world gathered together to

worship and hear the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The messages in the main rallies were: Set Apart for God (salvation), Set Apart for Purity (abstinence before marriage), Set Apart for the World (missions), Set Apart for God's Purpose (life calling), and Set Apart for Life (lifelong relationship). The missionary speaker did a great job of showing what it means to give your life for Christ. Marilyn Laszlo, a missionary to Papua

New Guinea, shared how she spent 24 years with a single tribe to learn their language, put it in writing, and then translate the Bible. The highlight of the convention had to be the message given by Kevin Myers, a Wesleyan minister from Lawrenceville, GA. He used the passage about David delivering food (including cheese) to his brothers on the battle lines.

He equated it with delivering cheese pizzas today. He asked the teens if they would be willing to set apart their lives for God

> even if it just meant obeying by delivering cheese pizzas. They responded by signing a pizza box and placing it on the main platform. It was glorious to see thousands of pizza boxes piled up as a monument to lives fully devoted to Christ! Many also placed theirs in a separate location indicating they were answering a call in to full time
