**SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW**

**REGULAR CLASSES:** The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

**Note:** Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed. **Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs** will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

**Stud Dog Class** - shall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his Get only  
**Brood Bitch Class** - shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny only

**Braze** - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed and identical ownership  
**Team** - shall be for 4 dogs of the same breed and identical ownership  
**UNOFFICIAL CLASS - Gun Dog Class** - shall be for hunting English Springer Spaniels

**Parade of Titleholders** - is open to any title-holder of any country  
**Parade of Veterans** - shall be for all dogs and bitches seven years of age or over

**PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES** Judge: Ms. Heather Mueller

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Springers at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.  
Senior Class for Springers at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.  
12-18 Open for Springers at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.



## **VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES**

Judge: Ms. Heather Mueller

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years for Springers at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

Over 9 years for Springers 9 years of age and older.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- the building will open at 7:00am on the show day, Sept. 2<sup>nd</sup>. On Friday, Sept 1<sup>st</sup>, the building will be open from 4:00pm until 8:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must **use the designated areas.**
- The ESSCC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The English Springer Spaniel Club of Canada and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the ESSCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.

Exhibition	dogs 6 months and over, not in competition

A separate entry is required for each class entered in obedience trials. To facilitate setting up the jumps in open and utility classes please designate jump heights on the entry form.  
Entry fees will be refunded for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the show. To obtain this refund a letter from a Veterinarian must be presented to the Trial Secretary **before** the commencement of the trial.

### ENTRY INFORMATION:

- All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY.
- No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show / trials secretary after the closing date and time.
- Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

### EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
- Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$50.00 (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.
