Traveller, born Hull YKS, [Ref 1881 Census piece 1755, fol 35, p2, LDS 1341422]. Richard wrote to his son Richard in NZ on 21 Feb 1865 from Noke Hall, Bulphan, ESS, ENG.

National Probate index for 29 Jul 1864 shows effects of less than 20 pounds, the will and 2 codicils.

Richard - notes arrived in Wellington, NZ in 1842 on the "London". He transferred to Nelson on the "Blossom" and quickly made his mark. He is found in December 1842 in a court case and a ploughing competition. He is thought to have lived at Redwood Valley until he married Mary Ann (a widow) 02 Oct. 1844. Richard, Mary and family resided at Richmond where he was Wesleyan Preacher, Registrar, Magistrates Clerk, Teacher, Postmaster, etc until in the 1860s he moved the family to Motueka then Lower Moutere and built "Hulmers" with money left to him by his stepmother Penelope. He started an orphanage there and for 10 years became known as something of a philanthropist. He died of throat cancer.

Mary - notes: Mary arrived NZ 12 Dec 1842 on the "George Fife" with first husband John Coster (who was killed Wairau Massacre - Jun 1843). Mary and baby Agnes then lived first with Redwood family before moving to Port Nelson. After John died, she met Richard Wallis and married him at the Wesleyan Chapel, Nelson on 02 Oct 1844.

They started an orphanage at The Gables in Motueka and Later at Hulmers in Hursthouse Street. Hulmers was built about 1860? with money from the estate of Richard's step-mother Penelope Dean.
