Membership Types

Ordinary Members

- An Ordinary Member must be 18 years of age or above. Persons who are either The HKIEd TCSEN graduate or 1.1 equivalent shall be eligible to be an Ordinary Member.
- Associate Members who have an Associate Member for not less than two years and who have special 1.2 contributions to the Association may, subject to the approval of the Executive Committee, apply to become an Ordinary Member.
- 1.3 The Executive Committee, in their absolute discretion, may resolve to invite such person to become an Ordinary Member.
- 1.4 Ordinary Members have the right to attend all general meetings of the Association. Every member shall have one vote
- 1.5 Ordinary members have the right to vote or be voted as Members of the Executive Committee.
- 2 Associate Members
 - Persons, study or graduate the special education course in other institutes may, subject to the approval of the 2.1 Executive Committee, apply to become an Associate Member.
 - Associate members have the right to attend all general meetings of the Association. 2.2
 - An associate member shall be entitled to all, the rights of Ordinary Member except the right to elect or be elected 2.3 as Members of the Executive Committee.
