

## AIRFRESH

AIRFRESH was founded in the spring of 1994. Because at that point in time all the members were already involved in different bands, it started just for fun. Contrasts - the different backgrounds of the musicians - attracted themselves and contradictions could be unit. A new sound was created in which also the violin could develop its atmospheric melodies.

Although they had no vocalist at that time, they played several gigs since the summer of 1994. In autumn they recorded a 4 tracks promo on their own to get some feedback on their music.

When Kirsten, the female vocalist, joined AIRFRESH in jan/95, they had the chance to express their feelings, thoughts and attitudes through lyrics. For AIRFRESH the lyrics have a special meaning, the claim of the statements is to reach the listeners and to stimulate their minds. Every thought has its sound, every sound a meaning.

With this new motivation and a huge timespent on the songs, they

recorded a professional demotape in march of 1995 called "Kitschchaos i.S.". In and outside of Germany the tape received some very positive resonance from fanzines and radioshows.

Strengthened they started to write new songs. Contrary to "Kitschchaos i.S." now the vocals could be involved now from the biginining, the songs became clearer and more compact. In august' 1996 they went into studio again and recorded these songs on their new demotape "Masse Mensch".

After finishing the recording Kai, the violinist, left the band because of temporal problems. Nevertheless he will play some more gigs with AIRFRESH further on. The music of AIRFRESH combines melody with hardness. elements of Metal. independent and Punk with progressive ones. Of course the best is to make your own mind about it.

"I think during the last years the scene in Germany became much smaller.
