The band was formed in 1993, at that time we had two other members which we kicked out later because they sucked. After playing a few shows we recorded a demo called "Misanthropy", that was limited to 200 copies. We then hooked up with Catharsis Records to help fund a CD project, River of Corticone, and it was released about a year later.

**Which are your influences ?**

We are influenced by the typical old school bands that need no further glorification. The new stuff out there is getting too much influence from the old way. Like old BATHORY.

**Who does the songwriting ?**

Wor writes most of the music because he writes insane riffs, they should be worshipped by all bands across the globe, but not copies.

**What do you think about the fashion of Black Metal ?**

There is no Black Metal, it's all Death Metal. They all sing about death and the dark way of life, it's all Death Metal.

**What do you think about religion ?**

No religious bullshit. Complete atheism.

**Do you have plans for another release in the near future ?**

We have an upcoming 7", the material for it is recorded, but we want to wait awhile before we release it. We might also do a split with a yet-to-be announced band.

**Are you interested in recorded with a larger label ?**

We're looking at offers and if we think that they're not a bunch of people that deserve to be murdered we'll give

them a chance. If they fuck us around we will murder them.

**Does the band have any political views, and why ?**

The S.A. are not a political band in any way whatsoever. There are a few misconceptions of what we represent, but these are from insignificant cretins which are below us. Each individual member has their own beliefs, but together, as a nucleus, politics do not come into the musical or lyrical structure. On the whole, we support war, apocalypse, and the crushing of false trends within our cherished scene. Apart from that is irrelevant and unimportant...

**What has been released so far, and what's coming up ?**

It began with our first demo, "Misanthropy" in 1994. After this, we released a second demo, entitled "Nebulous" which was a warm up for our first CD release called "River of Corticone". The CD came out near the death of summer, 1996. In the very near future, we are releasing a 4 song demo called "Of Moonlight and Fire". This demo will be limited to 100 hand numbered copies and never reprinted. Three of the four songs will never be available again, on any format. The fourth song, "Wedge Formation" is appearing on a split 7" with American band DETERIORATE, which should be released in the coming weeks. "Wedge Formation" will be re-recorded along with another 45 minutes or so of new material in the summer of this year, with the release of the second CD in the autumn of 1997.

**Do you have any labels interested in you ? Are you taking any offers ?**

We are always willing to entertain offers from any label. Just contact Catharsis Records. Currently, we have traded with many labels from the U.S.A., Europe, Australia and Canada, and are featured on many a mail-order catalogue.

**Do you play very many shows in your hometown ?**

As few as possible. The people here that are into our music are very genuine, although their numbers are extremely small. Playing shows here is quite a letdown, actually, as the majority of the crowd prefers to sit on their ass and drink while a band is playing. Their loss.

**What kind of response do you get when you play ?**

The people that understand it love it, and the others just look and wonder.

**Do you have much of a stage show ?**

Just the necessities. Nails, spikes, fire, leather and lots of blood.

**Do the members of the band have jobs ?**

We do what is necessary to obtain what we need.

**What bands do you listen to ?**

Anything Metal that is harsh and abrasive. Hate inspiring music. There are many bands, but they will not be mentioned here.
