

**MIDSOUTH REGION MEGA-RALLY 2007
STABLING INFORMATION**

Fee: \$25.00 per night per stall – No exceptions!

! LAYOVER ARRANGEMENTS SHOULD BE MADE PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT THE RALLY !

Horse management will not be in the barns before the scheduled rally arrival times.

You will be allowed to arrive early to your competition stall if possible (this will save moving bedding). You will also be allowed to layover in your competition stall if at all possible (if KHP needs you to move we will tell you where to move to). If you arrive before the official move in time of your rally, you will be allowed to move your horse into its stall. We are hoping for a more staggered move in to avoid traffic congestion in the barn area. You will be allowed to drop off tack and equipment in the aisle only. Tack rooms cannot be set up until official move in time.

! No parents will be allowed to stay in the barn area and help set up. PARENTS MAY HANG FANS ONLY !!!!!

! IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL COMPETITORS:

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2007 USPC HORSE MANAGEMENT RULEBOOK, WHEN UNMOUNTED, ACCEPTABLE FOOTWEAR IS A SHOE THAT IS SECURELY FASTENED, ENTIRELY CLOSED, COVERS THE ANKLE, IS THICK-SOLED AND IN GOOD CONDITION. TOTALLY CANVAS OR CLOTH SHOES OF ANY KIND ARE NOT ALLOWED. A STURDY LEATHER SHOE OR BOOT IS RECOMMENDED.

THIS RULE WILL BE STRESSED FOR ALL COMPETITORS AND RECOMMENDED FOR ANY PARENTS WORKING IN THE BARN AREA OR LOADING/UNLOADING HORSES.

! STALL CARDS - All horses must have a **COMPLETE** proper stall card, which will remain on their stall as long as they occupy that stall. Early arrivals and/or layover horses must have stall cards. Any unattended horse/pony without a stall card will be penalized and/or fined. There will be a \$25 fine given to the Club if the Pony Clubber is not in active competition or **MASSIVE** penalty points if they are in active competition.

! BEDDING – You must supply your own bedding for each stall. You can bring your own or purchase it in Lexington. Don Devers sells bagged shavings, straw and hay. He is located inside the KHP. Expect to have a minimum of 4 bags of shavings or 2 bays of straw for your horse. **YOU MUST PROVIDE ADEQUATE COVERAGE ON THE ASPHALT.** The stalls all have asphalt floors, which is a very hard surface. This expectation also includes horses that are in layover stalls.

! MOVING BETWEEN RALLIES – Parents, coaches, and DCs can help to move any competitor that is doing another rally. This move can begin when Horse Management releases the team/rider. Any competitor in show jumping, or tetrathlon, who is remaining for eventing, is to move to the layover stalls when their rally is completed.

! HORSE MANAGEMENT – The 2007 USPC Horse Management Rulebook will be the rulebook for Horse Management. Horse management scores begin on the move in day for each rally. All horses, including early arrivals or layovers, must have proper care. Any safety violations or untidy horse management can and will reflect upon their club members who are still competing.

! EQUIPMENT - Kentucky Horse Park rules require that fans be plugged into 3-prong outdoor adapters which are then to be plugged into grounded 3-prong outdoor-duty extension cords.

Midsouth Mega-Rally Stabling Schedule

This chart will help you figure out how many nights during Mega-Rally you will need a **lay-over stall**. Remember the only stabling included in the rally fee is for the night(s) between "Move-In" and "Awards." (Typically at the end of a rally you would leave and return home, but at Mega-Rally you can opt to do more than one rally, stabling your mount at the Horse Park between rallies.) If you need a stall for other nights you will need to reserve a lay-over stall.

Decide which rallies you are attending. Then highlight/circle/mark the dates of the rally on the chart. Draw a line from the "Included" stabling of the first rally to the "Included" stabling of the next rally. If there is a column space(s) between your rallies, your mount will need a lay-over stall for each column/night not included.

You need to send in a 'Stabling Request Form for Lay-Overs' along with your check for the days needed to the Stabling Organizer.

In the example below the Pony Clubber is attending the Dressage Rally and the Horse Trial/Eventing Rally. PCer arrives on Tuesday morning and moves in for Dressage Rally. Tuesday night stabling is included in the rally fee. Dressage Rally is over on Wednesday. The Horse Trial does not move in until Thursday morning. PCer will need a Lay-Over stall for Wednesday night.

If you are doing a rally (listed on left) and will need a stall on the **EVENING/NIGHT** of:
