"Wisdom from Wes" - Dealing with Down Time

If you train consistently and run a fair amount of races, you will inevitably have to deal with down time.

By definition most athletes can expect to have peak performances for a period of eight to ten weeks. That is not to say that you can't run races the rest of the time. I have found that twice a year it becomes necessary to rest the body from training intensity and emotional drain.

Some of the signs indicating the onset of that period may include elevated pulse, noticeable fatigue, weight gain, desire to race and even onset of colds, flu, injury, etc. No matter how hard you try, only time will get you

back on track for serious training and competition. The magic number also seems to be eight to ten weeks. If you have to race during that period, be under trained and plan on a much longer recovery. For me the Peachtree always falls into that period and my body feels like it did a hard half-marathon. I then chill my efforts into August and start anew in September.

In my younger years I noticed a drop of somewhere below five percent in performance. Now that my time has slipped by almost

ten minutes in a 10k, that number has gotten much bigger. Because my training mileage has been reduced by fifty percent since the young years, the amount of training tempo and mileage really suffers. I turn more to bicycling where the efforts are harder to quantify.

The emotional challenge, at times, can be more difficult to deal with. If you're preparing for a fall race like the Ekiden or WARR, your emotions are playing ping-pong. You know that you need the training, yet those first steps are ever so difficult. This is where I lean on my summer cross-country kids who I do not want to disappoint. If a teenager can show up at 7:45 most weekday mornings,

surely I can make myself get off the sofa and get my butt in gear.

The best advice I can give you at this point is to share your frustration with a running buddy and look to better running days ahead.

Race Review - Peachtree Road Race

The 38th annual Peachtree Road Race went off without a hitch on July 4th and as always, the Dusters were well represented. This year's edition featured (relatively) cool temperatures in the upper 60s at the start as well as lower than normal humidity – the best weather we've seen in about 10 years! As a result there were some pretty fast times posted and several Dusters had their best ever Peachtree effort.

As usual, Wes Wessely was the first Duster to cross the line, finishing in 40:03 which was good for fourth in the Men's 55-59 age group. Barbara Chandler was the top Duster Female, finishing in 41:29, 75th overall and 8th in the Masters Divi-

sion. (I had the pleasure of starting the race with both Wes and Barbara, but only managed to stay with them for about 10 meters!) Top 1000 finishes, good enough to claim a special finisher's mug, were also turned in by Tripp Hullender (42:13), Don Hamel (43:39), and Gregg Davis (44:20).

Once again the best part of the race was the finish area. Over 600 Delta employees and family members enjoyed food, drink, massage tables, and much needed shade at the top of the Piedmont Park meadow. As always a big Thank You is due our partners at *ignition* led by Marianna Popp for their hard work in setting up and staffing the Delta finish tent.



Air Transportation

Delta employees and retirees can take advantage of ID90 interline agreement with Qantas, Air Canada and United. JetStar, Qantas' low fare carrier, has confirmed discounted rates from Honolulu. Check www.jetstar.com for current rates.

There is also an option on Korean Air from Norita and Seoul. DL employees and retirees are eligible for an ID96 on Korean. Delta has non-stop service from Atlanta to both Norita and Seoul. As of 8/6/07, a sample roundtrip ID96 from Seoul to Sydney was \$478.68 and from Norita to Sydney was \$522 – these both included taxes and applicable fees.

Qantas has provided a special WARR space available airfare applicable for those who do not qualify for interline discounts with Qantas and have registered for WARR. Required Travel Documents

In addition to a passport, you will need to secure an ETA (Electronic Travel Authority) to enter Australia. An ETA is equivalent to a VISA but there is no stamp or label in your passport and there is no need to visit an Australian diplomatic office to submit an application. If you are eligible, the ETA is issued electronically by a computer system for the Department of Immigration in Australia. You must have an ETA issued prior to travel to Australia. Cost is approximately \$15USD.
