- 1. Matthew 20:26 minister (diakonos) -> "one who executes the commands of another, especially of a master, a servant, attendant, minister; from diako meaning to run errands."
- 2. Matthew 20:27 servant (doulos) -> "a slave, bondman, one who gives himself up to another's will."
- D. I Corinthians 4:1-2, "Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful."
 - 1. I Corinthians 4:1 ministers (hyperetes) -> "any one who serves with hands: a servant"
 - 2. I Corinthians 4:1 stewards (oikonomos) -> "a steward, manager, superintendent (whether free-born or as was usually the case, a freed-man or a slave) to whom the head of the house or proprietor has intrusted the management of his affairs"
 - 3. I Corinthians 4:1 mysteries (musterion) -> "a hidden or secret thing, not obvious to the understanding, a hidden purpose or counsel"
