Office

During the week Juma paid rent of Tsh 240,000 for the year 1 August 2008 to 1 August 2009 to Juma Hassan Chibaya the owner of the office in Manzese and they signed the contract. During the week Juma Hassan Chibaya contributed his time to paint the inside and outside of the office in Manzese using the left over blue paint from the Mabibo office. Mejah sent a message to Elaine that he will organize painting of the logo and name of UWABA. Ally Athman suggested that we prepare a notice to put in the Mabibo office saying we have moved to “Manzese Argentina Mtaa wa Sisi kwa Sisi karibu na Mid Land Bar”. Juma bought a lock for the new office – he has one key, Elaine has another and Juma Chibaya has another.

Road safety project - Wamba Memorial Fund

On Wednesday Juma and Markus visited HUWATA. HUWATA said they would prepare a report of the schools visited. They will also rent bicycles and cycle with Juma and Markus to Kigamboni next week.
