FORMULA VEE 40TH BIRTHDAY PARTY JUNE 19-21, 2003 ROAD AMERICA, ELKHART LAKE, WISCONSIN, USA

This memorandum contains information relative to the Formula Vee Birthday Party celebration planned in conjunction with the Chicago Region SCCA June Sprints & reg; , June 19-22, 2003. There is a test day on Thursday, June 19, which is track sponsored and participation must be arranged directly with Road America. Both the Brundage Cup race (SCCA National Competition and equivalent licensed drivers only) and the Vintage Class (SCCA Regional and Vintage Licensed drivers and other approved licenses) race will be the only two races conducted on Saturday afternoon, June 21,2003. The Brundage Cup, included within the Sprints FV National race, will be the first race of the afternoon with the Vintage Vee's the second and last race of the day. Both classes of FV will have a practice and two qualifying sessions during Friday and Saturday. The Vintage Race Group will be a Restricted Regional race under a separate sanction number from the June Sprints & reg;. SCCA and Road America will provide the usual coverage for liability and participant accident insurance.

The remaining race groups for the June Sprints will be conducted on Sunday, June 22nd.

Anyone wishing to race in the Brundage Cup race must be an SCCA member and have an SCCA National Competition License or an SCCA Dual License (National & Pro). It is possible to obtain a National License based upon your personal driving experience and the level of competition license you presently hold; such as an FIA Class C license. Compliance with this requirement must be established in advance. Please notify Bill Bonow or Bob Lybarger of your status and they will work with you to obtain your SCCA National License. A current medical examination will also be needed.

Your car must pass SCCA technical inspection and comply with the current General Competition Rules and Formula Car Regulations.

The Vintage Race will require SCCA membership and a competition license from a recognized vintage organization, an SCCA Regional Competition license or a recognized competition license from another sanctioning body. Contact Bob Lybarger or Bill Bonow for further licensing information. The acceptable licenses need to be included in the Supplemental Regulations of the June Sprints so we need your information as soon as possible.

Accommodations for the weekend of the June Sprints are usually difficult to find close to the track, but Road America, Inc. has a list of motels/hotels and bed-and-breakfasts in the surrounding area. Some locations may be as much as 30 -50 miles away in towns like Fond du Lac, Manitowoc and even Green Bay or Milwaukee. Camping, both motor home and tent camping, is available at the Track, Plymouth Rock Campground (½ mile away) and the Sheboygan Marsh State Campground. The entry form and parking request hopefully will be mailed about the middle of May, 2003. It will also be available on the Chicago Region SCCA web site in PDF format for printing. At this time, electronic registration is not available, but the Region is working on it. Stay tuned. The entry fee has not been decided but last year the Sprints entry was \$250.00 US.

Transponders are required for all race cars in the National/Brundage Race and may be required for the Vintage Race as well (to be decided shortly). The Chicago Region SCCA has a very few self-contained, rechargeable, battery powered units available to rent (rental in the past has been \$100 for the weekend with a refundable deposit of \$300). Contact the Chicago Region SCCA office on or about June 1st to reserve a rental unit. SCCA uses the AMB system so if you have a compatible transponder on your car, you only need provide your transponder number on your entry form.

If you have a race car available to rent for the Birthday Party, please contact Bill Bonow; the same for anyone who wishes to rent a car. Bill will make every effort to match requests.

An awards banquet will be held Saturday evening, June 21, 2003, for all FV attendees with a reception preceding. Dress will be race track informal. There may be an extra charge for the banquet.

A display of FV memorabilia is planned so if you have something to be included, please contact Barb Deer for the arrangements. Security for these invaluable items will be provided.

We would like to contact all previous SCCA National Formula Vee champions. If you have any information concerning these individuals; name, address, telephone, etc. please let Butch Deer know as soon as possible. Although we have access to the information for the most recent past, it would be helpful if we could get the names back to when SCCA began holding National Championship races.

If you have any suggestions of potential sponsors for this event please contact either Bob Lybarger at LRE or Butch Deer at DRE.
