## BASKETS IN A CORNER


Makes 12" sq. finished

## Background

cut 2 5 3/8 in sq. then cut diagonally

cut 8  $2 \times 3^{\frac{1}{2}}$  rectangles


cut 2 3 7/8 sq. then cut diagonally for corners



cut 4 2 3/8 in sq. then cut diagonally cut 1 5 3/8 in. sq. then cut diagonally

## Color for other 2 baskets

Can be made scrappy



- 1. Starting with large background triangle mark 2 inches in from side corners for handle placement. Cut  $1\frac{1}{4}$  in. bias strips for handle. Fold in half right sides together attach.
- 2. Sew a 5 3/8 in. color triangle to triangle with handle. Make two with one color fabric and two with the other color.
- 3. Sew a small color triangle to a background  $2 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$  in. rectanale. Make 8. 4 and 4 mirror image.
- 4. Sew these strips to side of basket for feet.
  - 5. Sew smaller background triangle to basket base.
  - 6. Sew four baskets together handle toward the center pressing seams in alternating directions.
