## PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

These instructions are for one 12" finished block (12 1/2" unfinished)

Background: white or white on white

Star Center 1: patriotic print

Star Center 2: light blue, small to medium size print

Star Corners: medium blue, small to medium size print


Star Points 1: red, small size print

Star Points 2: patriotic print

This is the ninth block in a twelve block sampler series. Make blocks in the colors indicated for the block of the month drawing, and make another block in the colors of your choice. At the end of the year you will have 12 blocks for a "Star Studded Sampler" of your own.

Background	A: cut 4	2 7/8" squares	cut diagonally once	
	B: cut 4	2 1/2"squares		
	C: cut 1	5 1/4" square	cut diagonally twice	$\boxtimes$
Star Center 1	D: cut 1	4 1/2 " square		
Star Center 2	E: cut 1	5 ¼" square	cut diagonally twice	$\boxtimes$
Star Corners	F: cut 4	2 ½" squares		<u> </u>
Star Points 1	G: cut 2	5 1/4"" squares	cut diagonally twice	$\boxtimes$
Star Points 2:	H: cut 4	2 7/8" squares	cut diagonally once	
Thing a good 1/4" are all sweeps accomble as fellows				

Using a scant 1/4" seam allowance, assemble as follows



- ✓ Sew each A to an H (press to H) 8 units
- ✓ Sew 4 A/H units to B (press to B) 2 with B on right, 2 with B on left
- ✓ Sew 4 A/H units to F (press to F) 2 with F on right, 2 with F on left
- ✓ Sew A/H/F units to A/H/B units (press to A/H/F)
- ✓ Sew 4 Gs to 4 Cs (press to G)
- ✓ Sew 4 Gs to 4 Es (press to G)
- ✓ Sew G/C units to G/E units (press to G/E)
- ✓ Following diagram layout, sew into 3 rows press top and bottom rows away from the center, press the middle row to the center
- ✓ Sew the 3 rows together following the diagram

Follow the diagram layout carefully when sewing units together.

(An optional color placement would be to make E out of the background fabric, use the same dark fabric for D and F and a medium fabric for G and H)
