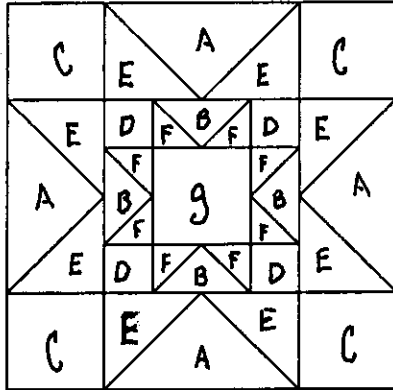


Rising Star – August Drawing

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING.

CLARIFICATION: You will see “finished” block size shown frequently in quilting instructions. This refers to the size of the block in the finished quilt. The actual or working size of the block will be ½ inch larger in each direction. This allows for the quarter inch seam allowance on each side.

For the purposes of these star blocks, each one will be 12 inch finished and 12 ½ inches actual or working.







Background – white or white on white

Outer Star Points – blue print

Inner Star Points – red small print

Star Center – red & blue print

Cutting:

Background	A: cut 1	7 1/4" square	cut diagonally twice	
	B: cut 1	4 1/4" square	cut diagonally twice	
	C: cut 4	3 1/2" squares		
	D: cut 4	2" squares		
Outer Star Points	E: cut 4	3 7/8" squares	cut diagonally once	
Inner Star Points	F: cut 4	2 3/8" squares	cut diagonally once	
Star Center	G: cut 1	3 1/2" square		

Construction: Refer to diagram for piecing layout. Use piecing and pressing guidelines from prior month's directions.

This is the eleventh block in a twelve block sampler series. Make blocks in the colors indicated for the block of the month drawing, and make another block in the colors of your choice. At the end of the year you will have 12 blocks for a "Star Studded Sampler" of your own.
