Safety Log Book

Many of us already carry cellular phones, but this doesn't do us any good if we don't know who to call. We have decided, after an unfortunate incident last year, that we would carry two copies of a log book which will have some personal data of yours. One book will be carried by me, and the other by someone else on the ride so that if the person with the book goes down, we have a backup.

The reason for this log book is to carry instructions on what you (the injured) want us (the other riders) to do for you in the event of an accident. Information contained is an emergency contact phone number that you want us to call, and how you want your bike and belongings taken care of (left on side of road, or towed) in the event you crashing and being rendered unconscious.

This information is personal, and confidential. It will be used only for this purpose and none of the phone numbers will ever be used, except in the event of an emergency. You only need to sign in once, I will take care of making the copy and updating the log book.
