1999 Re-Cap by Jim Holzberger

In June, Oregon Outing III; four days of riding, eating, camaraderie, and hot-tubbing. Riding got great on Sunday when we got into the Blue Mountains in Northeastern Oregon.

In July, there was Laguna Seca; ten days without rain, riding every twisty road we could find between Washington and Monterey, CA. If you ever find yourself down that way, check out Skaggs Point Road between Stewarts Point and Geyserville. It has some of everything, ridge running, knarly tight twisties, and wide-open sweepers.

In August, Oregon Camp-In; Bob Kramer and I were the only WA members to go and meet with the Oregon crowd at Cascade Locks. We took the 3-day scenic route that included more exploration of Eastern Oregon. We found SR-218, a 36 mile ribbon of twistiness between Fossil and Antelope (remember the Bagwan and his Rolls Royces?).

Packwood Pursuit in September; Dan Hytry, Bryan Bailey, and Jim Masterman got an early start on Friday and spent the day playing in the Gifford Pinchot (see warning below.) I met with them that evening at Dan Meekhof's residence in Packwood (thanks for putting us up, Dan.) Saturday morning, Larry Dunn from Silverdale joined us on his CBR1000 for a ride down the backroads to Hood River for lunch at Mickey D's. That afternoon our ride took us to Mt. Hood, east to Maupin, SE to Antelope (218 had been freshly chip-sealed) and then northeast to Condon, where we spent the night. There, we had the largest piece of Prime Rib I've ever been served in a restrauant. Sunday brought new discoveries, 141 to Trout Lake and Ice Cave, FR 23 north from Trout Lake (like FR 25 from Randle to St. Helens used to be - smooth, twisty, very little traffic).

Looking back, I can't help but notice that I enjoy rides that take me away from the traffic of Pugetropolis. Where but in Condon, Oregon or some other small town will kids ask if you are someone famous? Or where a clerk in a gas station/general store/post office is overjoyed to find that you have \$10 in change to sell her (the nearest bank is 50 miles away).
