MEMBERSHIP

Professional Membership

Associate Membership

Affiliate Membership

Available to other TRiO professionals or persons who do not qualify for Professional Membership under the provisions of ARTICLE III, SECTIONI. Affiliate members must pay conference registration fee, and are not entitled to hold office or vote.

Lifetime Membership

Is conferred by action of the Executive Board of KAEOPP. Lifetime members are entitled to attend any organization function free of charge, are entitled to vote, but are not entitled to hold office.
