Here is a baptism hymn I wrote in about 2 hours, so it is still a first draft. Instead of being a hymn about only what God does in and through baptism, I wanted to broaden this hymn to include Christ's baptism in the broad sense—his life, death, and resurrection (Mk 10:29) and then traverse from there in to the actual Sacrament of Baptism. The melody I chose is "Arise" from Walker's Southern Harmony of 1835. This is one of the better American melodies I have come across. Many of our melodies are trite sounding—this one actually has depth, rhythm, and singability! Well, let me know what you think and provide any suggested improvements.

In these cases it makes sense to cross-reference the hymn numbers between the two books.

Rachel's Cross-Reference, assembled by Rachel Moldenhauer, accomplishes this task. In part 1, simply look up the number of the hymn in TLH on one side and scan to the corresponding CW hymn number on the other. Part 2 lists the hymns in CW order. You'll find this list a handy tool as your congregation makes the transition from one hymnal to the other.
