**UNANIMOUS RESOLUTION OF EXECUTIVE OF KENTVILLE
AND AREA MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION ("KAMHA")**

NOVEMBER 21, 2004

unanimously**

WHEREAS the Executive of KAMHA believes that a majority of KAMHA members would presently vote against amalgamation of KAMHA and the East Kentville Minor Hockey Association;

AND WHEREAS the Executive of KAMHA continues to agree in principle with the idea of amalgamation.

BE IT RESOLVED that:

- (a) the executive of the Acadia Minor Hockey Association ("AMHA") shall forthwith distribute the feedback questionnaire to parents, coaches and players with regard to the team selection evaluation process;
- (b) once the results of the feedback questionnaire are known, they shall be considered by AMHA and AMHA shall convene a special public meeting to address concerns with amalgamation and the amalgamation process;
- (c) AMHA shall start to place greater emphasis on communication with its membership including the preparation of a periodic newsletter.
