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## Background

Koichi was already showing great promise in sumo wrestling, when he lost his entire family in the great Kanto earthquake of 1923. Thereafter, he was taken in by his sumo trainer, and redoubled his efforts at training, both in gratitude toward his trainer and in memory of his older brother, himself a skilled sumo wrestler. He rose quickly through the ranks of sumo wrestling, rising as high as Ozeki (second ranked wrestler) in the national tournaments, before he became entangled in political troubles. As the Japanese government became increasingly a military controlled fascist state, Kameyama (as he was known to the public) tried to use his reputation to turn the political tide. He failed to change the public's opinion, but succeeded in making many political enemies.

Following the invasion of Manchuria in 1931 and an attempt on his life, Koichi decided to leave Japan. Luckily, he already had made friends among the Yakuza, having befriended one sumo obsessed oyabun. The yakuza arranged to have Koichi smuggled to England with a tea shipment.

There, Koichi made a new start and began to teach Japanese culture and language at a British school, while himself studying Western culture and continuing a political crusade against the Japanese government. In 1933, Japan withdrew from the League of Nations, and the NAGS Society determined that Japan was becoming a trouble spot, and needed an expert for the area. Koichi readily agreed to join the Society, having wanted to take a more active role in changing the course of Japanese history.

### **Personality**

Koichi is curious, and open to new ideas. He believes that one should work to fix society from the inside, but, failing that, turn to less than legal methods if necessary. He speaks English with an educated upper class accent. He always complains about British tea, and claims that it is inferior (and would much prefer green or oolong tea, which are harder to find in the West). He is somewhat worried about returning to Japan, and hopes he will not be too easily recognized. He complains often about the changes made to the sumo wrestling ring in 1931, to anyone who will listen. The changes reflect a lack of respect for tradition, an essential aspect of sumo wrestling, and the increase in ring size changes the strategy. The worst change, in his opinion, is the time limit set on tachiai, purely for the purposes of radio broadcasting.
