Competitive Girls High School Soccer

Soccer players in 9th through 12th grade (fall 2009) are invited to play for a girls high school competitive team within the Glacial Drumlin United (GDU) soccer club. GDU will have 1-2 girls teams (possibly U-16 and U-19) that will play within the Madison Area Youth Soccer Association (MAYSA). Approximately 400 soccer clubs are in MAYSA with over 13,000 players participating. GDU is a member of MAYSA and Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association (WYSA) that welcomes players from Cambridge, Cottage Grove, Deerfield, Lake Mills, Marshall and Waterloo.

GDU is a non-profit, tax-exempt corporation. Home games are conducted on the Glacial Drumlin Fields (located at the intersection of Hwy. BB Krueger Rd. in the Township of Deerfield (3 miles north-east of Deerfield)) and other area fields in surrounding communities.

Typically 1-3 practices and a game occur weekly. Games may be scheduled on Saturday and Sunday afternoons. The season runs September through October. During the season, each team's schedule consists of eight (classic) games against other teams in the greater-Madison area. Coaches will inform their players of the practice and game schedule at the end of August.

Fees: Competitive player's fee is \$350 for the fall season. If your daughter played last fall and has the Adidas black and gold shorts and black and white GDU t-shirts, you may get a \$25 discount. Please indicate on reg. form the number your daughter would like (put a couple of alternate numbers just in case). Fees are used to pay the MAYSA team fee, uniforms, coaching and referee fees, equipment, field maintenance and insurance. Fees do not include tournament fees. Tournaments are an extra fee determined by the coach and team.

Equipment: Players receive a GDU black t-shirt, GDU white t-shirt, shorts and soccer socks. Players provide their own shin guards, soccer cleats or athletic shoes; baseball cleats are not allowed. Shin guards are mandatory and players must wear soccer socks over their shin guards.

To enroll in the program: register online, \$100 deposit, a copy of player's birth certificate and 1" x 1" photo of the player are due by June 25, 2009 and the remainder of the fee (\$225) will be due at the first practice. Please add a \$10 late fee if registering after July 1, 2008. Teams will be filled on a first come-first serve basis until teams are filled (18 per team).
