NOW COME the above-named candidates for Precinct Committeeman of the Libertarian Party of Illinois in the former 39th Representative District of Du Page County and as and for their Offer of proof state as follows:

1. The Libertarian Party received about 26.2 percent of the votes cast at the November, 2000 General Election in the 39th Representative District.
2. As a matter of law, and to the extent the boundaries of the 39th Representative District are changed by legislative redistricting, the Libertarian Party is an established party in any Representative District which includes any portion of the former 39th Representative District.
3. Each of the above candidates are running for office in a precinct whose boundaries were included in the former 39th Representative District.
4. The electoral district for purposes of signing each candidate's nominating petitions was limited by the boundaries of the precinct. Only registered voters in each precinct were eligible to sign the respective nominating petitions.
