
The San Antonio International Airport (SAT) is located approximately eight miles or 15 minutes from the downtown central business district. SAT is serviced by 14 air carriers: Aerolitoral, American Airlines, **America West, Continental, Continental Express, Delta and Delta Connection carri**ers (ASA, Comair and Skywest), Mexicana, Midwest, Northwest, Southwest and United. Airlines servicing SAT provide non-stop flights to 28 destinations including Atlanta, Baltimore, Chicago O'Hare, Cincinnati, Dallas-Fort Worth, Dallas-Love Field, Denver, El Paso, Guadalajara, Harlingen, Houston Intercontinental, Houston Hobby, Kansas City, Los Angeles, Memphis, Mexico City, Minneapolis/St. Paul, Monterrey, Nashville, Newark, Orlando, Phoenix, Salt Lake City, St. Louis, Tampa, and Las Vegas, Nevada.



Ground Transportation:

- •Nine on-site rental car agencies with curbside shuttle services to pickup/drop off centers
- •Taxicabs-\$15-\$17 to downtown (Up to 4 may share a cab)
- •Shared-ride shuttles-\$9.00 one-way to downtown, \$16.00 round-trip
- City bus-\$0.75 to downtown (1 hour scenic route)

Federal Inspection Station:

A Federal Inspection Station is located inside Terminal 1, which processes non-stop flight arrivals from international destinations. The station supports operations of the U.S. **Customs Service, U.S. Immigration and Naturalization** Service and the U.S. Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service.



Directions to the Hotel from the Airport: Take Hwy 281 South to IH-37 South (to Corpus Christi). Exit Commerce Street and turn right. Go 6 blocks to Navarro Street and turn right. Go 2 blocks to College Street and turn left. The hotel will be on the left.
