Your experiment may look at Solubility, Diffusion, or any other property of the cube. At some point in your write-up you should include the suspected purpose of this material. You need not use all of your materials. Good luck.

- 8. Analysis and Interpretation of Data including Error (4)
- 9. Possible Experimental Errors (3)
- 10. Conclusion (4)
- 11. Recommendation for Further Experimentation (4)
