

Ft. Campbell Hunting and Fishing Unit Permit Information

1. A valid Tennessee or Kentucky fishing and/or hunting license with all appropriate state tags and permits is required to hunt or fish on Ft. Campbell. When hunting migratory waterfowl, hunters must have in their possession, in addition to all other required licenses and permits, a valid Federal waterfowl stamp, signed across the face of the stamp.
2. As of 1 March 2000, in accordance with AR 210-21, Army Ranges and Training Land Program, 1 May 1997, paragraph 5-12e, completion of an NRA hunter safety course or equivalent is mandatory before individuals participate in hunting activities on Army land **regardless of age**.
3. A Ft. Campbell Hunting and Fishing, Fishing or Recreation Permit is required for anyone age 16 years and older to participate in outdoor recreation activities on Ft. Campbell to include hunting, fishing, boating, scouting, dog training, field trials, archery, horseback riding and camping. No post permit is required for youth ages 15 years and under for any activity other than **hunting**. All youth must show proof of successfully completing a Hunter Safety Course in order to receive a Ft. Campbell Post Permit for hunting.
4. Ft. Campbell Permits are available only through the Hunting and Fishing Unit for the following recreation activities and are valid 1 Mar 02 through 28 Feb 03:

BIG GAME - **\$15.00** – Deer, Turkey, Dog Training, Archery, Horseback Riding, Camping, Field Trialing, Hiking, Boating

SMALL GAME - **\$15.00** – Quail, Rabbit, Squirrel, Waterfowl, Dog Training, Archery, Horseback Riding, Camping, Field Trialing, Hiking

COMBINATION - **\$25.00** – Includes Big Game, Small Game and Fishing

FISHING - **\$10.00** - Fishing, Archery, Horseback Riding, Camping, Hiking, Boating

RECREATION - **\$10.00** - Archery, Horseback Riding, Camping, Hiking, Boating

Free Post Permit - Disabled veterans who possess a valid Disabled Veteran Hunting License from their State of residence. Youth ages 15 years of age or younger participating in hunting activities and Hunter Safety Course requirements have been met.
5. Ft. Campbell Hunting and Fishing Unit does not publish specific deer harvest data to include in requests for information, however it is available for review at the Hunting and Fishing Office.
