### FTPAM AutoCAD Scholarship Program 2006

To continue and achieve its objective of professional development of its members, The Filipino Technical Professionals Association of Manitoba, Inc. once again is offering AutoCAD Scholarship to a deserving member who believes that this will help establish a better future and benefit his/her career/professional development.

### **Purpose:**

This Scholarship has been established by FTPAM for the support and encouragement of a Member who needs financial support, training and employment opportunities.

### **Eligibility:**

The Candidate must be able to meet the following to apply for the Scholarship.

- Must be a member of FTPAM. Preference shall be given to active members. An active member is
  one with paid membership dues. New members are considered active with paid membership dues for
  the current year. To reactivate membership, outstanding dues since being inactive must be paid in
  full before submitting application. Current Directors are automatically disqualified for the scholarship.
- A resident of Manitoba. Applicant must be a resident of Manitoba for at least three (3) months.
- 18 years of age or older with technical background and must be able to meet the requirements of the program. Applicant must meet minimum age requirement and be eligible to enroll on the courses/program of the Scholarship.
- <u>Unemployed or under-employed.</u> Applicants who meet this criterion will be given priority for consideration.
- <u>Must be able to demonstrate a need for financial aid and not have other resources available such as EI Benefit.</u> Applicant must be able to show a proof to the Scholarship Board that he/she needs financial assistance.
- Must be able to prove the value of the scholarship to his/her professional advancement. Applicant must convince the Scholarship Board that the Scholarship will benefit his/her career, professional development and future plans.

### **Program of Study:**

Course Outline: Offered at RED RIVER COLLEGE

- AutoCAD 1 (Level 1)
- AutoCAD 2 (Level 2)
- AutoCAD 3 (3D) Optional

#### Value:

The value of the scholarship will not exceed \$1000. The program only offers cost of tuition fees. Transportation to and from training sites, textbooks, etc. are not supplied or provided. Depending on the availability of funds after completing AutoCAD 1 & 2, the successful candidate can choose to take AutoCAD 3 in the condition that the scholarship is only responsible for the amount left on the scholarship value.

#### **Conditions of Scholarship:**

- Applicants must fill out application form and submit on or before the dead line date on the form.
- Applicants must meet the eligibility requirement set by the scholarship.
- Applicants must ensure that he/she is qualified to enroll on these courses by checking with the college. Qualified to enroll means he/she must meet the requirements of the college to include the prerequisite of the courses offered on this scholarship.
- The course must be taken at RED RIVER COLLEGE.
- The successful candidate should arrange the course schedule and must start AutoCAD 1 before the end of year 2006. Failure to enroll in the year 2005 and/or 2006, means candidate is no longer interested in continuing the scholarship.
- AutoCAD 1 & 2 must be taken in two consecutive semesters; exception will only be given in special circumstances approved by Scholarship Board.
- The successful candidate must advise the Scholarship Board in writing of his/her intentions to continue the optional AutoCAD 3 immediately after finishing the first two courses. Failure to advise means no longer interested in pursuing AutoCAD 3.
- If candidate chose to pursue AutoCAD 3, the scholarship is only responsible for the amount left on the scholarship value.
- The successful candidate must pay the tuition fees initially and will only be reimbursed after completing and successfully passing each course.
- The successful candidate must maintain FTPAM membership for the duration of the scholarship.
- Scholarship is non-transferable.

#### Scholarship Board and Administration:

A Scholarship Board shall award the scholarship; members consist of the following FTPAM Board of Directors.

- · President and Chairman of the Board
- Executive Secretary
- Treasurer
- Membership Director
- Training and Development Director

The Scholarship Board shall be responsible for publishing the availability of the scholarship, receiving applications, selection process, advising candidates on the results, arranging payments from the scholarship fund, and reporting to the general membership on the outcome.

The Scholarship Board may conduct a personal interview, such of the candidates as it finds desirable to see. The interviews, if any, will be after the dead line date of the application.

No Scholarship shall be awarded on any occasion if the Scholarship Board shall be of the opinion that there is no qualified candidate.

### **Power to Vary:**

It shall be lawful for FTPAM on the recommendation of Scholarship Board at any time and from time to time to amplify, vary or rescind all or any of the conditions relating to the said scholarship and the award and tenure thereof specified in the preceding clauses and to add any further or substitute other conditions, provided that no such conditions shall be inconsistent with the general purpose of the said scholarship.

It shall be lawful for FTPAM on the recommendation of Scholarship Board at any time and from time to time to amplify, vary or rescind any rules and regulations that it may deem necessary or desirable for the purpose of facilitating the award of the said scholarship or in any other way giving better effect to the purpose of the said scholarship, provided that such rules and regulation shall not be inconsistent with the general purpose of the said scholarship or with the condition specified in the above clauses or other conditions from time to time being relating to the said scholarship and the award and tenure thereof.
