A volunteer orientation day will be held in next 2 weeks to coordinate opening the room and assisting in outfit selection. Jen, Tracy, Girl Scouts ans many others have volunteered. Local cleaners donated men's suits, and most donors want to remain anonymous. More funding is needed for after June 2007, more The response has been that such a program is long overdue. Possibly there can be a partnership with the Americorp Attire for Hire program next year.

Verizon Wireless Hopeline Cell Phones Project continues.

2006 Through My Eyes: Voices Against Violence, Voices of Hope has received manuscripts and poetry.

Garden of Hope – The Triumph Head Start National Make a Difference Day gardening project has been put off until spring the garden. The 10/28/06 event brought in 337 outfits.
