CHANGE OF DATE FOR SUBBIES AND INTERS REHEARSAL

The Church require the hall on the 11th, 12th and 13th October. All subbies, inters and juniors will practice together on Wednesday 10th November from 4.00pm - 6.30pm at the hall. This will be a good opportunity for FINALE rehearsal.

CONCERT

Special rehearsal for all pupils: Saturday 20th November from 1 - 4.30pm at the Norlane High School. That means everyone from Tinies through to Seniors. The teachers have requested that parents not stay for this rehearsal but leave children at the hall and collect them at 4.30pm. There will be a lot of work to get through and the fewer distractions there are the better. The girls will be going through all the items on the concert program in order. They do not require any costumes just their usual blak leotard.

DAY OF CONCERT

 - The girls will all remain in the dressing room with designated helpers and are not permitted in the audience.
 - The concert runs from 2.00pm - 5.30pm approx. with a 15 minute interval.
