#### **Fees**

Second Term fees are now due and payable by mid-May. Unfortunately our Hall hire has risen unexpectedly by \$900 per year and our competition entry fees have also risen. As a result we have had to increase fees by \$5 per term.

Fees are now \$100 for Subbies, Juniors, Inters and Seniors (\$90 for second child) and \$50 for tinies (\$45 for second child). We apologise for this unavoidable increase, but hasten to point out that it is still only \$2.50-5.00 per hour, which is still quite inexpensive compared with a lot of other indoor sports.
