Once the dates have been announced please make sure you have made **transport arrangements** and sometimes **accommodation arrangements** well in advance (not the day before)

Base make-up (Max Factor Pan Stick 109 Medium Moyen)
Eyelasher & Glue ("D") - Juniors, Inters and Seniors only
Lipstick (Indian Red, Scarlet Red or anything similar)

If it is in your child's best interest that they each have their own supply. They last for years, but if only a few have purchased these items then they feel obliged to share them which makes it very expensive for them. Please organise this early to avoid the rush before competitions. Before arrival to competitions please make sure that your base make-up and eyelashes are on your face. Do not arrive and ask someone else to put them on for you. Practice at home a few times. The rest of the make-up will be supplied by the club and will be applied at the competition.
