## Responses and Rebids in Uncontested auctions

With what hands will responder pass the opening bid?
If not vulnerable he may pass with any hand. Vulnerable normally pass with long hearts or with $0-1$ hearts and 5 or more spades
Meanings of other responses and rebids:
$2 \mathrm{H}-(\mathrm{P})-2 \mathrm{~S}$ is pass or correct
2H-(P)-2NT asks for opening values and opener's suit
2H-(P)-3C asking in other major by opener (spades if opener has hearts, hearts if opener has spades)
or natural with clubs (forcing one round)
2H-(P)-3D natural forcing one round
$2 \mathrm{H}-(\mathrm{P})-3 \mathrm{H}$ or 3 S is pass or correct

## Competitive Agreements

Responses after opponent's DBL
After 2H-(DBL), pass is waiting but not promise long hearts, 2 S is pass or correct, RDBL is any strong hand, 3C and 3D is natural not forcing

Responses after opponent's overcall:
DBL is not penalty, asks for the opener's suit, new minor suit is not forcing
Rebids after $4^{\text {th }}$ hand DBLs the response:
Rebids after $4^{\text {th }}$ hand overcalls:
Opener always passes either with hearts or spades over RHO DBL or any overcall

With what hands will responder pass the opening bid?
He mey pass only with 6-7 cards in spades and weak hand or with void in spades and weak hand

Meanings of other responses and rebids:
2S-(P)-2NT asks
2S-(P)-3C pass with any 6-4 minors or correct with a major
2S-(P)-3D asks for lenght in HEARTS, opener rebid 3H with 0-1 card in H and weak in spades,

3S with 2 cards in H and weak in spades, 3 NT with 0-1 card in H and 6-4 in
minors,
4C-4D with 2-3 cards in H and 6-4 in minors, 4 H with $\mathbf{3}$ cards in H and weak
in spades
$2 \mathrm{~S}-(\mathrm{P})-3 \mathrm{~S}, 4 \mathrm{C}, 4 \mathrm{D}, 4 \mathrm{H} .4 \mathrm{~S}$ is pass or correct
