HOLIDAYS—The term "Holidays" in this time table refers to New Year's Day, Lincoln's Birthday, Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Election Day, Armistice Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

RESTRICTED MONTHLY COMMUTATION TICKETS are not valid on Saturdays, Sundays or the following Holidays: New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. When any of the Holidays mentioned fall on Sundays and are observed on the following Monday, these Mondays will be considered as Holidays.

TRAINS WILL NOT BE HELD at Jersey City for ferries from New York between the hours of 5:00 P. M. and 6:30 P. M. Daylight Saving Time.

CHILDREN under five years of age are carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian; five years of age and under twelve, half fare; twelve years of age and over, full fare.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—Should any misunderstanding arise with conductors or agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with Passenger Traffic Manager, Midland Bldg., Cleveland, Ohio.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS—Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.
