<p>Payment Policies</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Tuition is a flat fee, and your payment reserves your spot in my teaching schedule. There are no refunds if you cancel a lesson. There are no make-up lessons outside of my teaching hours. ■ If you have to miss a lesson for any reason, you can: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Swap lesson times with another student in advance. 2. Come at another student's canceled-lesson time as they become available. 3. Forfeit the lesson. ■ If I cancel, I will give a full refund.
<p>Tuition Rates & Schedule</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Sept – May: \$100/month for 30-min lessons 36 lessons over 9 months for an average of 4 lessons per month. (the 36th lesson is the 1st week of June.) Due at the first lesson of each month ■ June – Aug: \$25 per 30-minute lesson Scheduled by sign-up ■ No Lessons: 1 wk. Thanksgiving (Nov 20 & 22) 2 wks. Winter Break (Dec 25 & 27, Jan 1 & 3) 1 wk. Spring Break (Mar 25 & 27) <i>You are not charged for these days</i>
<p>Teaching Philosophy</p>	<p>I am a certified Suzuki Method teacher. Some main Suzuki principles are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Parent: The “teacher at home” (until the student is age 11 or 12) Attends all lessons and supervises daily home practice ■ Student: Listens to the Suzuki CD everyday Memorizes music and reviews old pieces as a daily routine.
