JAMBOREE RULES

We shall follow high school football rules
with the exceptions listed below.

PLAYING RULES:

- » Games will consist of two halves of 10 minutes in length.
- » Time shall be a continuously running clock. The clock will only stop for time outs and injuries.
- » Each team will have one time out of one minute in length per game.
- » Games will be played on fields of 50 yards in length.
- » The first team listed on the schedule will receive the ball first, on the 40-yard line. At the start of the second half the second team listed will receive the ball first. There will be no kick offs.
- » The team with the ball continues until they lose it by way of either turn over, fumble, interception, or a turn over on downs.
- » When the opposing team receives the ball, it will be reset at the 40-yard line.
- » If the defensive team recovers a fumble or intercepts the ball, they will not be allowed to run the ball back. They will receive the ball on the 40-yard line.
- » Teams will not be allowed to punt the ball.
- » If a team scores a touchdown, there will be no extra point attempt, and the opposing team shall receive the ball.
- » The longest penalty allowed will be 10 yards. If there is not enough room for a penalty, then the penalty shall be half the remaining distance of the field and/ or lose of a down. This is up to the discretion of the referees.

OTHER:

- » Coaches will be allowed on the field between plays to arrange players and call plays, but must leave before the ball is snapped.
- » Every player must play in at least 2 halves of football. We want as many player to play as possible.
- » Coaches may freely substitute players though out the game.
