ANDREW JACKSON CLARK.

Andrew Jackson Clark was born in Morgan County, Illinois, September 8, 1840, and died at the home of his son, George H. Clark, at Langdon, Mo., January 20, 1917, aged 76 years 4 months and 12 days.

On January 1, 1861, he enlisted in Co. D 26th Regiment, Illinois Infantry. After serving four years he received an honorable discharge, July 20, 1865.

He was united in marriage to Lucy Jane Wilson at Springfield, Ill., Feb. 4, 1864. To this union were born fourteen children, four of which are dead, Lurama Ellen, Eva Anna, Mary Elizabeth and Violet Ethel. The ten living are: James William of Syracuse, Neb.; Stewart Jesse, of Custer City, Okla.; George Henry, of Langdon, Mo.; Mrs. Margaret Julia Dunlap, of Westboro, Mo.; Austin, of Kansas City, Mo.; Lora Wealey, of Wankee, Iowa; Mrs. Maud Rummerfield, of Plattsmouth, Neb.; Marion Jackson, Sylvester Oliver and Mrs. Grace Mutchler, of Tarkio, Mo.

He is also survived by 46 grandchildren, two great-grandchildren, two sisters and six brothers. His wife, Lucy Jane Clark, died at Tarkio, Feb. 16, 1909.

The funeral services were conducted at the Center Grove Church Jan. 22 by Rev. J. Jay Cokley of Westboro, Mo. Interment was made in the Center Grove Cemetery, Westboro. The
