

Cost Benefit Analysis

Round Bales v's Small Square bales

A cost benefit analysis of purchasing small v's round bales has been done and as you will see, the round bales have proven to be more cost effective. Allowing our funds to be better utilised.

Cost Benefit Analysis		
Item	Cost	Size (kg)
Small Square Bale	\$6.00	25
Round bale	\$55.00	360
Ratios		
small bales:1 round bale	9.166667	14.4

We can see from these figures that for the cost of one round bale of hay, we would receive 9.1 small bales. The weight of one round bale equates to 14.4 small bales. We estimate that if fed correctly, there would only be minimum wastage of the round bales, this would equate to approximately 25kg of hay or the equivalent of one small bale.

We are always looking for new feed and hay suppliers, please contact us if you know someone that might be able to give us a good deal.
