

HOST FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Housing Director will co-ordinate with the Host Family the pick-up schedule, time and site, in advance of the players team arrival. It is important that the players be picked up in a timely fashion so that they may get settled in before returning for the evening picnic. The players uniforms will be laundered as needed. The players will be with you a minimum of two (2) nights and a maximum of six (6) nights.

1. TRANSPORTATION:

- A. Host Families will provide transportation to and from all scheduled events, games, practice sessions, and events.
- B. Host Families shall work closely with team managers regarding when the manager wants the players at practice and games.

2. MEALS:

- A. Host Families shall provide three (3) meals for the players each day.
- B. Adjustments to the players eating habits might have to be made according to the State Tournament schedule and special activities schedule.
- C. Inform all players that you are to be advised if the player will not be present for a meal. Check each days schedule with the payers to avoid confusion.

3. SUPERVISION:

- A. Advise players that the Tournament curfew regulations stipulate that the player **MUST** be at your home **ONE HOUR AFTER THE DAYS LAST SCHEDULED ACTIVITY OR TOURNAMENT GAME.** (11:00 P.M. if no event is scheduled.) Players must advise you of their whereabouts at all times.
- B. In the event of an unauthorized absence or problem, contact the State Commissioner and Tournament Director. The players have been instructed as to their demeanor.
- C. Alcoholic beverages may not be served to the players.
- D. Families and Host Families shall receive permission from the team manager, and advise the State Commissioner and Tournament Director, prior to taking players out of the Host Family Town or City on any outing.
- E. Host Families are not to grant permission for any player to have access to their automobile. 16-18 year old division players that drive to the tournament will have their cars impounded until departure time for the team has been established after elimination from the tournament.
- F. In the event a player becomes ill, contact the team manager, the coaches, State Commissioner or the Tournament Director. Each participant is covered by the players own leagues Accident and Health policy. Also the players parents or guardian has signed a release granting the Host Family, the State Commissioner and the Tournament Director, the authority to approve any emergency treatment necessary during the tournament.
- G. Host Families will be notified of the team departure following the elimination from the tournament.
