Illinois Federation of College Democrats Endorse Obama for Senate

CHAMPAIGN, ILLINOIS – MARCH 5, 2004 – The Illinois Federation of College Democrats Executive Board voted unanimously to endorse State Senator Barack Obama for United States Senate during their monthly board meeting. Board members agreed that Obama is the best candidate for the Democratic nomination.

IFCD President Tarak Shah said "Obama's background as a professor makes him the right choice for students across Illinois. He will be a tireless champion in the United States Senate to make higher education more accessible for every Illinoisan who wishes to attend college or university."

Board members noted that there are many qualified candidates in the race for nomination, but none of them has a better record as a legislator then Senator Obama. His experience in Springfield will make him a powerful addition to Illinois' delegation in Washington.

In addition to their endorsement, the Illinois Federation of College Democrats also announced the support of five College Democrat chapters across the State including Illinois State University in Normal, Illinois Wesleyan University in Bloomington, Lake Forest College in Lake Forest, Parkland College in Champaign, and the endorsement of the executive board of the University of Illinois Urbana campus for Senator Obama's candidacy to U.S. Senate.
