On behalf of the Student Steering Committee and the congregation of the Protestant Chapel Community, I want to offer our delighted thanks at the incredibly generous gift of 40 hymnals from your congregation. We are just thrilled to have them, and we're touched by this wonderful gift from your church.

As Blair may have shared with you, a large percentage of the students involved in PCC are United Methodist, and of course most of them grew up in congregations that had the hymnal that you've just given us, rather than the old one from 1964 that is the only Methodist hymnal that PCC had on its shelves.
