

Transcriptions of Records for the name McHardy from the Scottish Old Parish Records for Glenmuick Tullich & Glengairn 201 vols. 1 and 2.

Transcribed by Sandra DeMartino, June 2002

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Transcribed and published here, with the kind permission of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and the Church of Scotland, is every reference I could find and decipher of the name McHardy from 1744 to 1854 in the Glenmuick, Tullich, and Glengairn Old Parish Records.

I have tried to transcribe the OPR records as accurately as possible, inserting a “?” where a word is completely illegible and [?] where I have enough to work with to make a reasonable guess. Any notations I have made appear in single square brackets: [...]. To help other researchers locate specific entries, I have standardized the dates of entry (but the entries themselves are word for word), listed records in the order they appear in the original volumes and included section headings, notes, and other navigational pointers. Original entries in the OPRs are often not chronological in order, pages are sometimes mistakenly duplicated or are out of order, and some entries are duplicated between volumes.

I have tried to make the transcripts as clear as possible; however, I cannot guarantee that I have not made mistakes, and some text is so difficult to read different people may decipher it in different ways. To ensure the accuracy of your own research, please make these transcripts a starting point and check them against the original records.

My source for these volumes is the microfilm produced by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, source call number 0993189, which is a photographed copy of the original Parish Records held by the Register General for Scotland in Edinburgh.
