All 8 lines of the first section start with the first letter of the Hebrew alphabet; thus the psalm continues until all 22 letters have been used in order. The psalm uses a variety of terms to speak about the Word of God. Each of the terms, found in nearly every verse, speaks of the Word of God in a particular way.
