Comments re: map of Oxford-on-Rideau

(Note that both lots and concessions are numbered on the map)

(The Rideau River runs north along the left side of this map)

1. The individual whose name appears on the map in respect of all or part of a particular lot may be either the owner of the property or a tenant.
2. It was on the portion of lot 17, concession 2, occupied by 'N. Purcel' that Joseph and Jane Bartley first settled as tenants. And it was on this lot that Jane would have died several years after Joseph's death. 'N. Purcel' was Nathan Purcell who married Sarah Bartley, Joseph and Jane's oldest daughter. Before their marriage his home had been on lot 22, concession 2.
3. A 12½ acre portion of lot 19, concession 2, was purchased by Joseph and Jane in 1849. They lived here at the time of Joseph's death in late 1851 or early 1852.
4. On lot 21, concession 2, appears the name of 'G. Barclay'. Jared had purchased 50 acres of this lot in 1846. Beside him, on the same lot, was Lancelot Johnston. Ellen and William Henry were probably born on lot 17 but Jared II, Jane Ann, Charlotte and Sarah Elizabeth were likely born on lot 21.
5. In 1846 Jane Bartley married Solomon Clothier, a son of Henry Clothier. At that time Henry occupied part of lot 16, concession 2, the lot adjacent to the original Bartley lot. By 1862/63 Henry had moved to lot 13, concession 6.
6. In 1859 Ellen Bartley married Samuel Bennett of lot 30, concession 3.
7. William Henry married Mary Harris and Jane Ann married Tiberius Harris. They were children of Robert and Clarissa Harris of lot 19, concession 1.
8. Jared II married Eliza Jane Bennett, the daughter of Joseph and Eleanor Bennett of lot 24, concession 2.
9. The Bartleys were members of St. James Anglican (Church of England) parish in Kemptville.
10. Approximately 30 miles north of the Rideau River is the Ottawa River and the City of Ottawa. Approximately 10 miles south of the southern limit of the map is the St. Lawrence River and the town of Prescott.
