Richard was born in Ireland. According to his death certificate, (and to a list written in an old-fashioned hand and found in a family bible) he was born on January 1, 1835.

On May 6, 1869, Richard married Ann Hannah, a daughter of Samuel Hannah and Mary Cassaday of Goulbourn Township, Carleton County, in the North Gower Weslyan Methodist church. Ann was born on April 6, 1847. Their farm was on lot 16, concession A, in North Gower township. There were three children of this marriage;
