

ANNIE LOUISA REDDICK

Annie was born on December 4, 1878 on the farm in Marlborough township. She lived with her mother in North Gower village beginning in 1902.

On July 11, 1910 Annie married Frederick Rowley Mills, the son of Thomas Mills and Martha McCordick. Fred was a carpenter. After their wedding they lived in Arnprior for two years, then moved to North Gower where he worked again as a carpenter until about 1917 when he opened the first automobile service garage in the village. For a number of years Fred was the Division Court Clerk.
