

SUSAN REDDICK

Susie was born on the farm in Marlborough township on November 21, 1880. On September 21, 1904, at her mother's home, she married John Clarence Leach of North Gower township, the son of John Leach and Maria Barrows. At that time Susie was living in North Gower village since her mother had left the farm in 1902. One of the witnesses for the ceremony was Bella Raine (who was married the following year to William Joseph Wilson of Kemptville); the other was Arthur Kendrick. The report of the wedding said that they would live in Kemptville.

From Kemptville Susie and Clarence moved to Rouleau, then to Noremac (since renamed Madison) where they homesteaded, then to St. Brieux, all communities in Saskatchewan. Clarence was a farmer and a carpenter. Robert already lived on Lulu Island, a suburb of Vancouver, and they moved there in 1936. Susie took care of Robert until he died a couple of years later. George and Agnes Davis lived about five miles from them.

There were four children of this marriage:

Susie died on November 5, 1966, Clarence on November 26, 1966, both at 85 years of age. They were buried in Ladner, B.C.
