- _____ 1 (5 gal.) water bucket, filled at night, to top off water buckets at late night.
(Stored empty in tack room during day)
- _____ Cotton lead rope
- _____ Extra halter
- _____ Salt block (holder optional; loose salt acceptable)
- _____ Snaps for tubs & buckets
- _____ Horse I.D. (stall card)

Feeding Equipment (per horse)

_____ All feed should be pre-packaged in PAPER bags – one feeding per bag, labeled with horse's name, day and time to be fed, contents of bag, competitor's name, club and number. The amount fed should be labeled on the bag and all bags need to be placed in a secure feed container with a lid that a horse cannot remove.

EX: Joey (the pony's name), Wed. PM feeding, ¼ pound of oats, Melanie Smith, WCPC, Competitor #42.
