Be a member!

Any Filipino citizen at least 18 years old who works and/or resides abroad or in the homeland who subscribes to the principles and program of MIGRANTE may apply for **regular membership**. Those below 18 may apply for **associate membership**. Just go to your nearest MIGRANTE chapter to enlist.

A chapter of MIGRANTE on the barangay level constitutes a membership of at least 15 individuals. A Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary-General, Deputy Secretary-General and Finance Officer are to be elected to serve as the chapter leadership.

Chapters can be set up by Filipino communities anywhere in the world. Here in the homeland, regional, provincial, municipal and city-wide chapters may also be set up where-ever it is deemed fit.

To date, our sectoral party now has chapters in 22 countries worldwide. In the Philippines, we have 10 regional coordinators.

Our Tasks to strengthen unity among organizations of Overseas Filipinos and their families in the Philippines and abroad

1. Strengthen cooperative relations with organizations of overseas Filipinos and other sectoral parties.
2. Develop a network among lawyers, church people, women's organizations and trade unions to assist our compatriots encountering problems on-site, especially undocumented Filipino workers.

3. Extend support to all overseas Filipinos working to advance their legitimate interests.



Our Efforts to help educate and raise the political awareness of Overseas Filipinos and their families

1. Develop an education curriculum, with modules and training kits to standardize the education and training programs for Overseas Filipinos and their Families.
2. Send timely statements, position papers, and primers on issues of the day and other issues affecting the sector.
3. Develop and conduct timely research studies on burning issues and concerns with immediate and long term impact on our sectoral work.

Our Actions via Legislative Measures

MIGRANTE's political platform shall address the problems of our sector. Hence, it must take vital issues which are relevant to us and the society at large, and migration issues that may affect the public. Our program of action must be practical, beneficial, and necessary:

Principally, work for the passage of laws and policies that will embody the aspirations of Overseas Filipinos and that will ensure the protection of their rights, interests and welfare, and conversely, work for the repeal of laws, orders, and resolutions detrimental to the welfare of Overseas Filipinos.

- ✓ Lobby for the ratification and full implementation of the *United Nations Convention for the Protection of the Rights and Welfare of Migrants and Their Families* by Host Governments of Overseas Filipinos.
